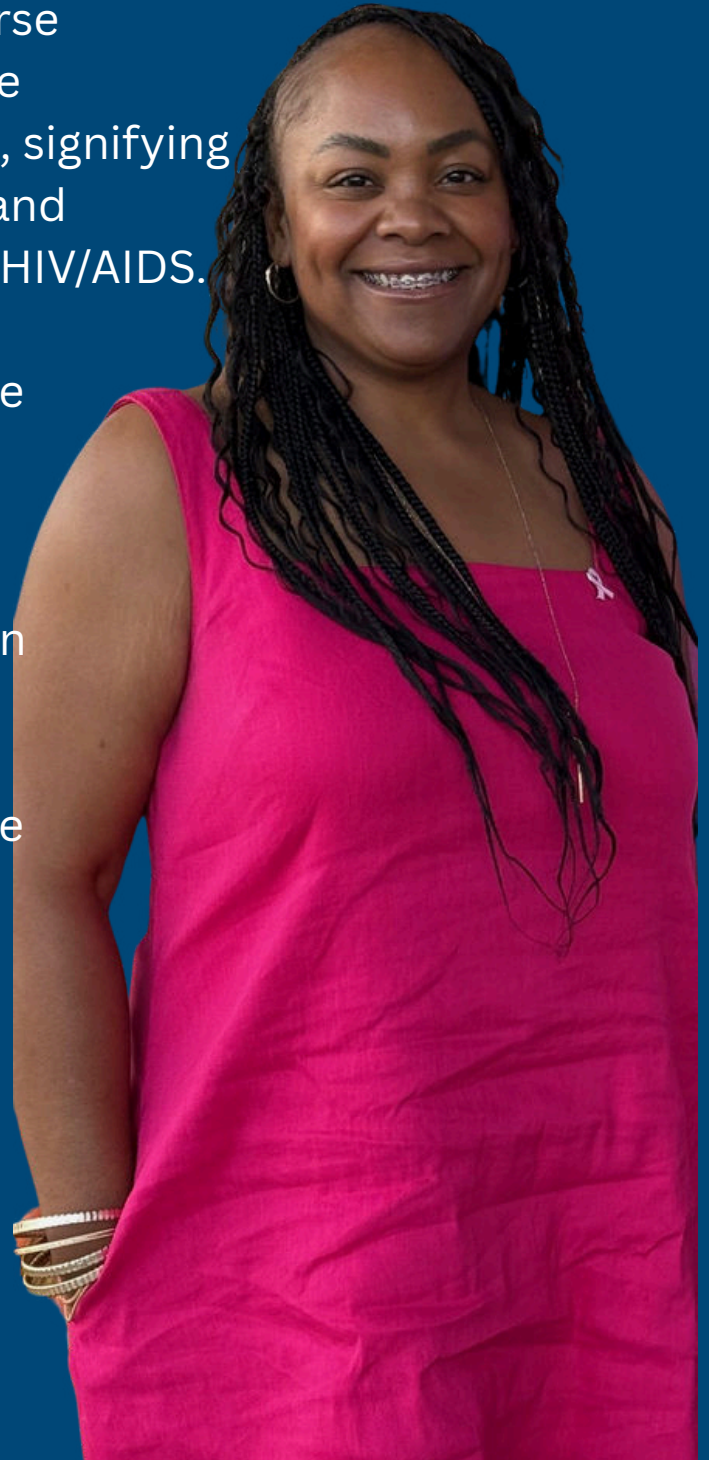
Meet Charlie Rose Bowling Green

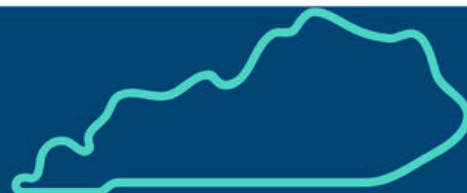

Prevention Made Simple

Did you know there's a daily pill that can help prevent HIV? It's called PrEP (Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis), and it's one of the most effective tools available to reduce your risk of contracting HIV. When taken as prescribed, PrEP can lower the chance of getting HIV from sex or injection drug use by up to 99%.

PrEP is recommended for anyone who may be at risk of HIV exposure—whether through a partner living with HIV, inconsistent condom use, or other factors. It's a proactive way to take charge of your health and protect yourself and those you care about.

At Matthew 25, getting started on PrEP is easy. You simply need to have health insurance and a negative HIV test, which our team can provide. From there, our knowledgeable and compassionate staff will help guide you through the process and ensure you have the support you need to stay on track. Reach out today to get PrEPared!
